Call for Youth Multi-Media Projects
on the Environment

The City of Los Angeles is hosting its annual Environmental Youth Conference (EYC) on November 4th of this year to foster youth awareness and civic engagement on behalf of urgent environmental concerns. If you are a youth (ages 12 to 18) or know of any youth who have a one-minute (or less) multi-media project about the environment (e.g. documentary, video journal, podcast et al) that can be shown or highlighted at the EYC, please email Million Trees Los Angeles at Lisa.Sarno@lacity.org by 12noon on September 5th. Please include the following information in your email:

- Complete contact information of youth(s) involved in the project (name, age, school/organizational affiliation, email address, and phone number)
- Brief description (1-2 paragraphs) of the project and how it addresses environmental issues
- All environmental multi-media projects will be considered. However, this year's panels will emphasize the issues of: 1) water conservation, 2) alternative energy and 3) sustainable consumption.
 - Sample projects include storm water capture through tree plantings, green technology such as solar and wind power, and eco-friendly clothing.

Applicants whose projects are selected will be notified by September 30th and must accept or decline by 5pm on October 7th.
