***Call for Youth Presenters***

The City of Los Angeles is hosting its annual environmental youth conference in November or December of this year to foster awareness and civic engagement on behalf of urgent environmental concerns. If you are a youth (ages 12 to 18) or know of any youth who are interested in participating as a presenter on a panel, email Million Trees Los Angeles at [Lisa.Sarno@lacity.org](mailto:Lisa.Sarno@lacity.org) by **12noon on September 5<sup>th</sup>**. Please include the following information in your email:

- Complete contact information of youth presenter (name, age, school/organizational affiliation, email address, and phone number)
- Brief description (1-2 paragraphs) of the environmental project that the youth would like to present at the conference
- All environmental projects will be considered. However, this year’s panels will emphasize the issues of: 1) water conservation, 2) alternative energy and 3) sustainable consumption.
  - Sample projects include storm water capture through tree plantings, green technology such as solar and wind power, and eco-friendly clothing.

Applicants who are selected to serve as panelists will be notified by September 30<sup>th</sup> and must accept or decline by 5pm on October 7<sup>th</sup>.
